

Military Spouse Entrepreneur Reimbursement Act

Section 1. Short Title- The title of this bill is the "Military Spouse Entrepreneur Reimbursement Act"

Section 2. Expansion of Authority to Reimburse a Member of the Uniformed Services for Spousal Business Costs Arising from a Permanent Change of Station-This section provides amendments to 37 USC 453(g) and all contents hereafter contain the amendments to 37 USC 453(g).

This section would perform two actions.

- 1. The first is it would expand the definition for military spouse relicensing costs to include the following costs.
 - a. Costs associated with a business license
 - b. Costs associated with permits

This will allow for these particular costs to be eligible for up to \$1,000 in reimbursement for a military spouse in connection with each Permanent Change of Station (PCS).

- 2. The second is that it would add a new paragraph to allow for the reimbursement of qualified business costs for a military spouse that may arise as a result of PCS orders. These qualified business costs are defined as the following:
 - a. Moving services for equipment
 - b. Equipment removal
 - c. New equipment purchases
 - d. Information technology expenses
 - e. Inspection fees

These costs will be eligible for up to \$2,000 in reimbursement to a military spouse in connection with each PCS.
